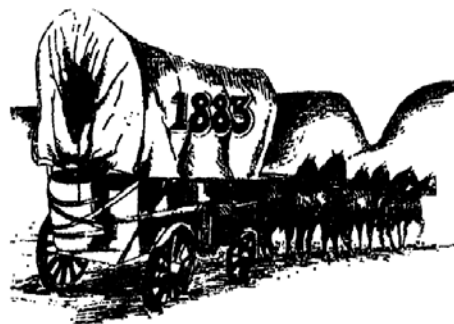


CITIZENS' SURVEY

One Councilmember is expressing interest in applying for grants for water extension projects. The various grants range from 1/2 million to multimillions, but require the City to provide matching funds, which vary from 50% to 95% of the grant amounts. The City has no reserve funds to provide matching funds and would need to take out loans. This would require rate increases for the citizens.

These grants and loans will allow the City to extend water service to most people in the Broadway area and a new 16" main on Main Street. These projects would provide for safe drinking water and fire flow protection. What are your thoughts?
