

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF UNION GAP AND THE CITY OF SELAH
REGARDING BUILDING INSPECTIONS
DURING TIMES OF BUILDING INSPECTOR ABSENCE**

This agreement is entered into this 8th day of July, 2008 between the City of Union Gap, hereinafter referred to as "Union Gap" and the City of Selah, hereinafter referred to as "Selah."

Whereas both cities employ building inspectors;

Whereas the building inspectors for each city will on occasion take vacation or other leave during the course of his or her employment;

Whereas each city seeks to provide continuity of building inspection service, even in the event of its building inspector's absence;

Whereas in the interest of providing such continuity of service, each city's building inspector can be made available to serve as a backup, on an as needed basis, for the other city in the event that the other city's building inspector is absent;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual benefits contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The recitals above are incorporated herein by this reference.

2. Union Gap shall make its building inspector available on an as needed basis to provide back up for the Selah building inspector in his or her absence. Provided, however, that Union Gap will only provide its building inspector as back up when it is advised of the need for back up at least thirty days prior to the anticipated need. Union Gap shall provide back up for Selah building inspector up to a maximum of two consecutive weeks or a total of four weeks in a year.

3. Selah shall make its building inspector available on an as needed basis to provide back up for the Union Gap building inspector in his or her absence. Provided, however, that Selah will only provide its building inspector as back up when it is advised of the need for back up at least thirty days prior to the anticipated need. Selah shall provide back up for the building inspector up to a maximum of two consecutive weeks or a total of four weeks in any given year.

3. Union Gap shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Selah against any and all claims or losses that may possibly result from the Union Gap's use of Selah's building inspector during the absence of Union Gap's building inspector. Said agreement to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless shall not extend, however, to any intentional or grossly negligent acts of the Selah building inspector.

4. Selah shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Union Gap against any and all claims or losses that may possibly result from the Selah's use of Union Gap's building inspector during the absence of Selah's building inspector. Said agreement to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless shall not extend, however, to any intentional or grossly negligent acts of the Union Gap building inspector.


5. Each city's use of the other city's building inspector during times of absence as set forth herein does not create the relationship of employer and employee between the city requesting backup and the building inspector provided by the other city. Each city remains responsible for its own building inspector as its own employee in all respects; including but not limited to, providing employee benefits, insurance, compensation, state and federal withholdings, and other items customarily provided to such employees.

Whereas both the City of Union Gap and the City of Selah employ building inspectors, and


Whereas the building inspectors for each city will on occasion take vacation or other leave during the course of his or her employment, and
