Valley Mall Boulevard Extension - III (South 16th Avenue to South 3rd Avenue)

Sealed bids for the above project will be received by the City Clerk, at Union Gap City Hall, 102 West Ahtanum, Union Gap, Washington, until 1:00 PM PST, February 19, 2008; at which time the bids will be opened publicly, read aloud and tabulated for submission to the City Council at a future meeting.

Bids received later than 1:00 PM, February 19, 2008 will not be considered.

This project provides for the construction of a roadway improvement project known as the **"Valley Mall Boulevard Extension - III (South 16th Avenue to South 3rd Avenue) Project"**. Under the Certification Acceptance (CA) authority of the City of Yakima this project includes approximately 1.44 miles of four-lane arterial roadway and appurtenances, two (2) single-span bridges over Wide Hollow Creek, waterline improvements, and sanitary sewer improvements. The work is separated into three (3) schedules as follows: Schedule A - Roadway & Structures Improvements including the construction of 1.44 miles of 4-lane arterial roadway, two (2) single-span bridges over Wide Hollow Creek, asphalt pavement, curb and gutter, sidewalk, center landscaped median, modification of traffic signals at the Valley Mall Boulevard / South 3rd Avenue intersection, channelization and signage, illumination, storm drainage facilities, median irrigation, streambank mitigation planting, waterline extensions, sanitary sewer, and other related construction; Schedule B - Waterline Improvements including approximately 11,500 L.F. of water main, valves, meters, hydrants, site restoration and other related construction; and Schedule C - Sanitary Sewer Improvements including approximately 6,250 L.F. of sanitary sewer pipe, manholes and other related construction.
